Shout out to our Track team. They've been running circles around the competition all season! While the Varsity meet was rained out last Saturday, our JV team did very well before getting soaked!

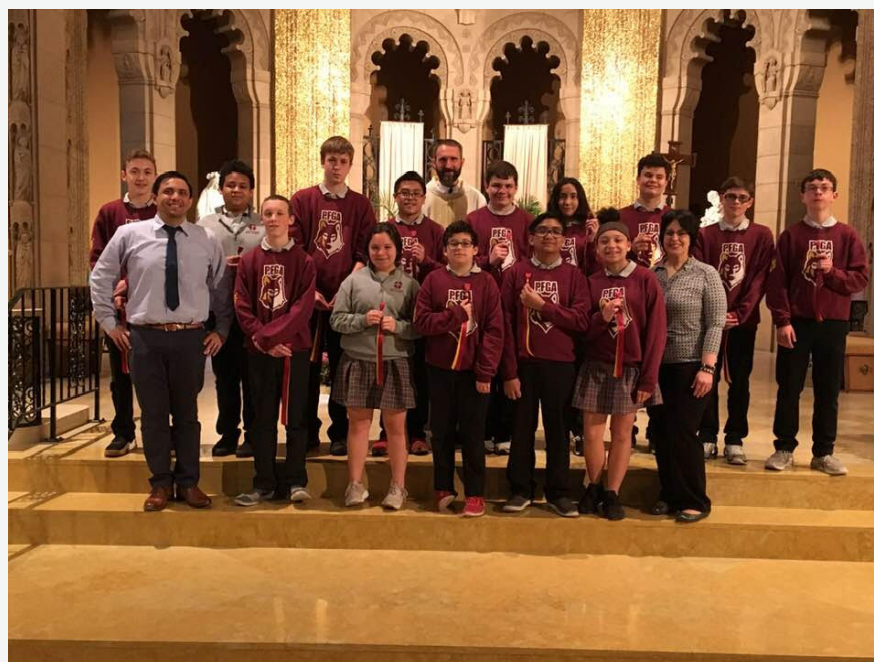
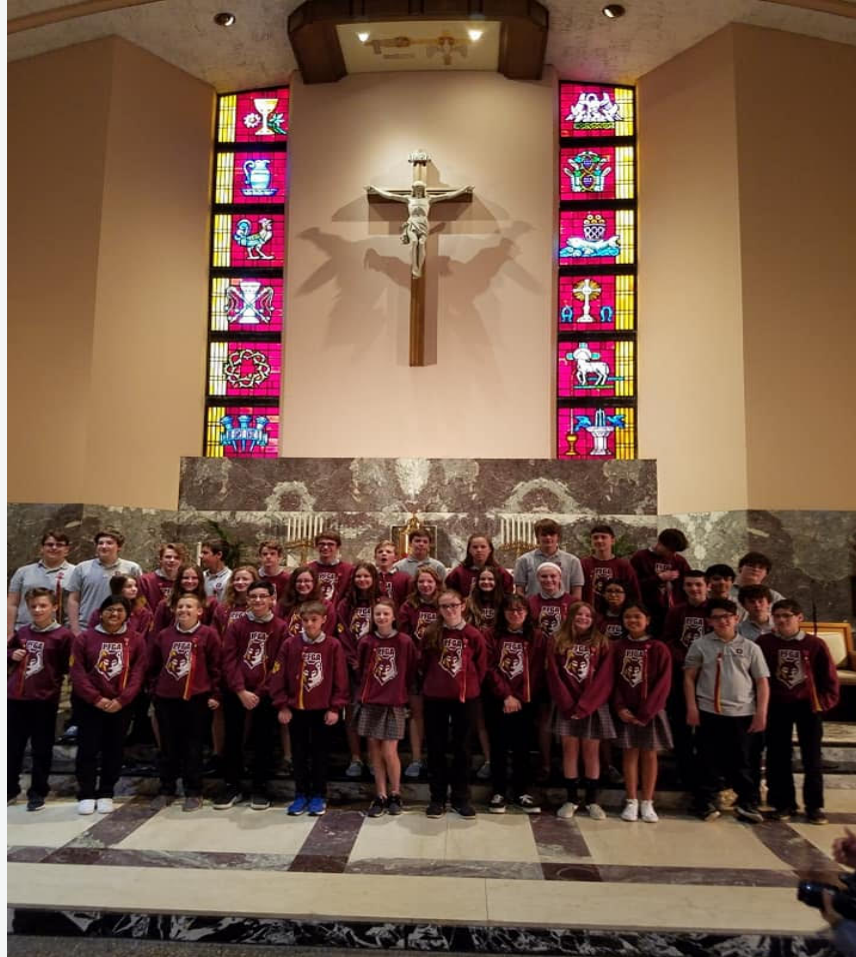
