COSTUME PARAMETERS

All students Pre-K through 8th may dress up for Halloween! Only school-appropriate costumes will be allowed. All children must be able to functionally use the washroom on their own with their costume on. For safety and insurance reasons, students will not be allowed to wear masks. Face painting IS allowed but must be related to the costume and students must be recognizable. Additionally, any item deemed a "weapon" of any kind will NOT be allowed as an accessory to the costume. Students must come to school fully prepared and in costume. No spray cans or hair coloring of any sort, spray string, face painting, etc. will be allowed at school for costume preparation or otherwise. If a costume is determined by a staff member to be a disruption in the classroom, gory, a possible safety hazard, or inappropriate (dress code still applies) the student will be sent to the office to call home for a change of clothes. These minor restrictions will hardly hamper the intent of the day - which is to have fun and exhibit some creativity in costume choices.

PARADE FOR PRE K THROUGH 2ND GRADES!

Each campus will have a Halloween Parade beginning at 8:10 a.m. with the Pre-K through 2nd grade students walking a big loop to show off their awesome costumes! Parents are invited to join the 3rd through 8th graders as they watch the parade and cheer on the kids.

North Campus 3rd through 8th grade students will line up outside around the main school building so PreK-2nd grade students can parade around the perimeter.

Grades 3-8 students at the South Campus will line up against the building in the back parking lot so PreK-2nd grade students can parade the perimeter of the lot.

CLASSROOM PARTIES

Each classroom on both campuses will have a classroom Halloween party hosted by the Room Parents at some point during the day. The party will include games, music, and Halloween themed snacks and treats. If there are any allergies your child has that you have not alerted the school of, please do so immediately. Halloween treats are allowed but must all be store bought and nut free.
