Please note that all school staff have received the following recommended preventive actions, based on CDC

• Wash your hands regularly with warm or hot soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw it in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces or objects. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at home, work, or school, especially when someone is ill.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

- Stay home when you are sick. Stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick. You will help prevent others from catching your illness. When at home, if possible, try to distance yourself from people who are sick.
- Contact your health care provider immediately if anyone in your home experiences any of the following symptoms: severe cough; rapid noisy, painful, or other difficult breathing; and dehydration.
- We ask that you notify our school if anyone in your home has any Coronavirus (COVID-19) or influenza symptoms. COVID-19 related student absences will be excused. We will work with affected students' families in providing schoolwork and alternate education arrangements (e.g. e-learning) to ensure the continuity of your child's education to the best of our ability.
- All principals and teachers are being asked to: Provide plenty of hand sanitizer, cleaning wipes and tissues through their offices and classrooms.
- Ensure school maintenance staff has additional resources needed to increase sanitation/cleaning activities.
