Dear Pope Francis Global Academy School Families,

The health and safety of students and staff at our school campuses is very important to us, and with the cold and flu season upon us, I want to assure you that we are taking precautions at school to prevent the spread of all viruses.

Flu and other respiratory viruses are typically spread via respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. Symptoms of the flu can include some or all of the following: fever, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches, headaches, fatigue, shortness of breath and/or vomiting and diarrhea.

To avoid contracting the flu or other respiratory illnesses, the CDC recommends the following methods of prevention:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

Additionally, the Archdiocese of Chicago has been working closely with the Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) and closely monitoring the advice of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

If you or someone from your family experiences concerning symptoms, such as severe cough; rapid noisy, painful, or other difficulty breathing; and dehydration, please contact your health care provider immediately for advice. If there is a significant diagnosis made by your doctor, I ask that you notify the campus that your child attends.

We will continue to provide updates and guidance as needed. You may also learn more through the CDC at www.cdc.gov/coronavirus.
